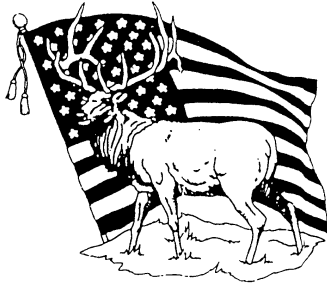
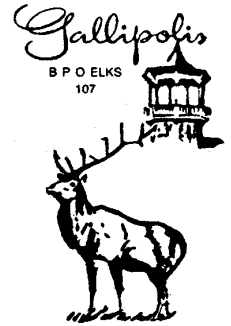
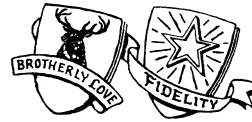

Foot Notes from the Secretary

I want to thank all the members that have paid their dues for the 2019 Lodge year. If you have paid your dues at the bar and haven't received your card, check at the bar because I normally will put your card there for you to pick up. If you have sent your payment in the mail and haven't received your card, give me a call, the mail has been a little erratic this year. If you haven't paid them yet and have misplaced the dues notice, you can just send a check or pay at the bar. The dues are \$74.50 for regular members and \$39.50 for life members.

Members that have not paid their 2018 dues have been dropped from the rolls as of 31 March 2019. However, you can still pay your 2018 dues along with the 2019 dues during the month of April and May without losing any time as an Elk member. A letter has been sent to you apprising you of your current status.

At the end of this past year, 24 members were dropped for non-payment or given an absolute demit, giving us a starting membership of 799, which is a gain of 2 members! This is a delinquency rate of 3%, ! Thanks to all the members for being loyal to our Lodge. Great Job!

The final results are in for the 2018 ENF per capita and the Gallipolis Elks are once again #1 in the State with a per capita of \$27.124 which equates to a cumulative donation of \$21,618 and #1 in the nation with lodges with a membership between 700-1100! Thanks again for supporting your Lodge and the ENF and thanks to Rick Van Gundy for doing an excellent job! Thanks Rick for a great job over the years and our charities appreciate you!
