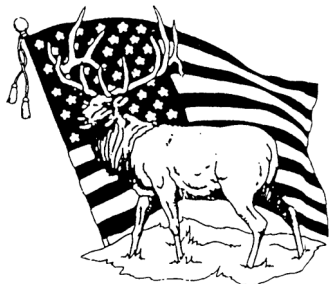
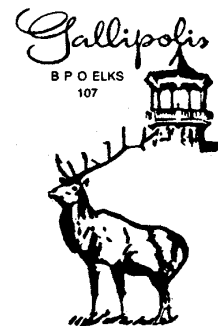

Here are some of the The House Rules as a reminder on the conduct that is expected by the members and their guests while visiting the Gallipolis Elks 107.

Operations of the clubrooms will be governed by the members of the Governing Body.

The clubrooms are operated for the benefit of the members, their families, and their guests. The members, their families, and their guests are to conduct themselves as ladies and gentlemen at all times.

Conduct in the clubrooms will be characterized by true gentlemanly decorum. No vulgarity, profanity, or indecent conduct shall be permitted. Suspension from social functions and the loss of club privileges may result from such activities.

Violence, in any form, will not be tolerated. Any and all offenders will be ordered to leave the premises immediately for the remainder of the day. The minimum sentence for the perpetrator will be suspension from social functions and the loss of club privileges for a period of six months minimum.

Profanity, obscene gestures, threats, or any other inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. After warning, the violator will be refused service and ordered to leave the premises immediately for the remainder of the day.

Any person who has applied for membership in this Lodge and has had a favorable report from the Investigating Committee read on the Lodge floor will be allowed additional visitation privileges that will allow them to visit the Lodge while being in the company of an Elk. These visitation privileges will apply until the ballot is held for this candidate.

Any person refusing to answer his or her phone calls must leave the premises immediately for the remainder of the day. Exceptions may be made for prank or annoying phone calls.

Any member owing any indebtedness to the Club or Lodge shall forfeit all social and Club privileges.

Any member and/or guest who destroys or defaces Lodge property, or unlawfully removes Lodge property from the Lodge premises, shall have appropriate charges preferred against them.

The Lodge, its officers, or members are not responsible for articles lost or stolen from the facilities.

Any suggestions or complaints must be presented, in writing, to the Governing Body and signed by the writer.

Any bartender or member of the Governing Body has the right to refuse service to any person, and that person must leave the premises immediately for the remainder of the day.

Any violation of the preceding rules will constitute Conduct Unbecoming of an Elk, thus placing the member in a position subject to disciplinary action by the Governing Body as per our By-Laws and/or the Grand Lodge Statutes.

Additional Guest Rules.

It is the responsibility of the member to register his guests who are 21 years of age or older, excepting member's spouse or significant other.

Guests must leave when the member who registered them leaves.

Guests permitted without an Elk escort are the spouse of an Elk, Gallipolis Emblem Club #199 members age 21 or older, un-remarried widows or widowers of an Elk and others pre-approved by the Governing Body. Guests may not bring guests.

Key cards, to gain access to the clubrooms, will be issued to the spouse of an Elk member from our Lodge upon the request of the member and will be issued to un-remarried widows or widowers of an Elk from our Lodge upon their request.

No Elk may bring in a guest(s) that will cause an issue with their, or any other person's spouse or significant other, or unless pre-approved by the Governing Body.

Guests are not permitted in the clubrooms on Lodge Meeting nights between 7:30 p.m. and closing.

No one under the age of 21 will be permitted to consume alcoholic beverages on Elk property at any time.

Children under the age of 21 are not permitted in the clubrooms unless accompanied by an Elk, or their spouse, and that Elk, or spouse, is responsible for the children's behavior and actions at all times.

Children under the age of 18 are not permitted in the clubrooms when there is entertainment or a special event as determined by the Governing Body.

Guest privileges may be revoked by any member of the Governing Body at any time with just cause.

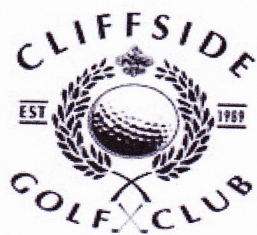
