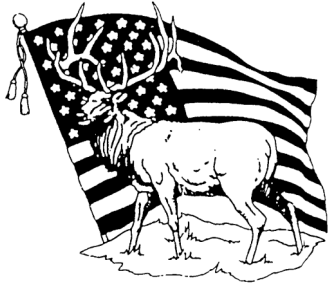

Our lodge membership grew this year from by 19 members as we finished the year with 828 members but we also had a delinquency rate of 3%. The ENF donations for the 2021-2022 year were \$24,104.50. This gave us a per capita of \$29.80 with a 27.94% membership participation. Thank you for supporting this worthy charity! With this per capita, we placed 3rd in the state. Berea was 1st with a per capita of \$76.004 followed by Kent at \$65.246. We placed 4th nationally in the 700 and greater membership group. In the Chairman's Challenge, we were 1st in the state and 15th nationally. Excluding our donations to ENF, our lodge donated \$44,240 to our community. With the ENF donations, the total was \$68,344. Great Job Gallipolis Elks!!

We had a really good turnout for the Installation of Officers on April 2nd.. I want to thank everyone for coming. I would like to thank the PERs for performing the Installation and I would also like to thank the Emblem members that served such great taco bar. Want to congratulate Kitty and Bill Griffith for their years of dedication to the Elks. Thank You!!




