Our lodge membership grew this year by 14 members as we finished the year with 845 members and a delinquency rate of 3%. Our ENF donations for the 2022-2023 year were \$28,530. This gave us a per capita of \$34.414 with a 27.86% membership participation. Thank you for supporting this worthy charity! With this per capita, we placed 3rd in the state and 2nd nationally in the 700 and greater membership group. In the Chairman's Challenge, we are first in the state. Excluding our donations to ENF, our lodge donated \$49,156 to our community with a total for the year of \$77,686. Great Job, Gallipolis Elks!!

We had a great turnout for the Easter Egg hunt, approximately 40 kids and 50 grownups. It was a little cool this year but everybody had a great time. Thanks to the officers and volunteers for cooking and serving the hot dogs, w/Remo sauce, chips and drinks.
