When Hurricane Helene continued its destructive path into North Carolina and caused all the flooding and damage in Asheville, Leading Knight Ron Pitchford and his wife, Shawna, quickly put together a relief effort to help the people in that area. They contacted Hendersonville, NC, Elks #1616 to coordinate the effort and to find out what was needed. A staging area was established at John Sang Ford dealership and requests were put on Facebook for relief items. The public response was outstanding. Items were collected over a two-week period and filled three box vans and one semi-trailer owned by Dave Martin. Numerous Lodge members donated their time to help with the collection of items such as food, water, tents, bedding, grills and charcoal, pots and pans, pet supplies, medicines, clothing, cleaning supplies and etc. Bridgeport donated equipment to load the trucks, while AEP and Walmart in Gallipolis and Jackson donated pallets of water and food plus there were over 300 donations from the Gallia community. The fully loaded box vans were driven to Hendersonville Elks #1616 by Tim Wright and Jonathon Elliott and the semi-trailer supplies were delivered to the Hendersonville Calvary Fellowship Church by Jeff Dyer. The items were then loaded onto other vehicles for distribution. A \$2500 check was presented to Lodge #1616 ER to help with their efforts to feed and support their community. The \$2500 check was comprised of contributions from the community, Gallipolis Elk members and the Lodge. All the donations were accepted with an abundance of appreciation.

A big thank you to the members that donated their time and efforts, our community and businesses that supported this effort. All this would not have happened without the outstanding backing of our members and community! The upcoming months of November and December are going to be just as busy with Veteran' Brunch, District Meeting, Thanksgiving, Memorial Day, Members Christmas Dinner, children's party with Santa, Christmas and finally our New Years' Eve Party.
